- Provide two letters of recommendation from a faculty member, principal, or counselor.
- Complete the Essay (500 words or less for each question).
- Provide proof of acceptance/enrollment/registration to a college, university, or technical school.
- Document status as a graduating senior from a Metropolitan Florida Chapter service area.
- Meet deadline requirements.

- Application and **all** required information must be submitted together.
