- The applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- The applicant must provide a transcript.
- 4) The applicant must be involved in community service or other volunteer activities and provide verification of a minimum of 50 hours of service.
- 5) Preference will be given to applicants who are African American graduates who reside in Seminole or Volusia County.
- 6) The selected applicant must provide Confirmation of Enrollment no later than four months after the start of the fall 2025 semester classes. If the confirmation is not received, the scholarship will be forfeited and may be awarded to another applicant.
